The Congregation Fair is located on Palace Green where the alumni team are present along with refreshments, university merchandise and photography stalls for students and guests to enjoy before and after the ceremony.

It is our hope that volunteers will engage in conversation with the graduates and their guests and will show affection for and interest in attendees.

Key responsibilities:
