

Make a Stratigraphy Sandwich

Try making your unique sandwich to understand how rock layers are accumulated and how a cross-section of excavation looks like.

Here are some suggested ingredients. Feel free to add your favourites!

- At least 2 slices of bread
- Spreads (chocolate spread, or jam)
- Fillings: Cheese, sliced meat, lettuce, tomatoes, or any ingredients
- 'Artefacts': Chocolate beans, dried fruits, nuts, or sweets

* Substitute allergens with alternative ingredients.

Method:

1. Apply spread to two slices of bread on one side only.
2. Place your fillings on one slice of bread layer by layer.
3. Add 'artefacts' between layers.
4. Top with another slice of bread.
