

## Make an Ancient Greek Black-Figure Pot

## You will need:

- A piece of card or art paper
- An orange crayon
- Black paint
- Washing up liquid
- Paint brush
- Cocktail stick







- 1. Take your piece of paper (it is good to put it on top of something like newspaper) and completely cover it with orange crayon. Don't leave any gaps!
- 2. Using a pencil, draw the outline of what you want to paint on your pot onto the now orange covered paper. You could do a person; Pegasus; a Greek god or goddess??



- **3.** Put some black poster paint in a pot and add a squirt of washing up liquid and mix it up.
- **4.** Carefully paint in the outline of your "figure". You can also add some of the decorative patterns from this page if you like
- **5.** Let it dry completely. Be patient!





- **6.** Being very careful using the cocktail stick draw on the details of your figure so that it reveals the orange underneath.
- 7. You can cut your piece of paper into a pot shape if you want or just leave it as it is.
