



The programme






TO BOTH INSTITUTIONS SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

To be considered eligible for admission to our programme, you will need to provide proof that you:

- Hold an Upper Second-Class Honours bachelor's degree or equivalent international or professional qualification with at least 180 ECTS
- Have gained five or more years of professional working experience by the programme start date

or

 Hold a master's degree with at least 90 ECTS, a recognised equivalent or higher degree

For applicants whose first language is not English:

• an IELTS score of 7.0 (no element under 6.0) or

IBT TOEFL score of 102 (no element under 23) or

an equivalent English language qualification may be required.

We also need:

- A curriculum vitae
- A letter of motivation
- An academic transcript (in both original language and English)

INTERVIEW

Qualified applicants will participate in an informal admission interview (held either on campus or via video conference) conducted jointly by the EBS and Durham programme directors. You will have the opportunity to showcase your academic and professional achievements and goals and gain further insights into the programme.
