With its wonderful view of the Cathedral, our spacious library is located in a quiet part of college near to the College Reception. It is open 24/7 for computer use, book borrowing and quiet study.

The library contains approximately 14,000 volumes, 13 network computers, a networked printer/copier and plenty of desk space.

The library holds copies of most core texts from course reading lists. Where possible, this is supplemented by a wider reading range. As these books are only available for Aidan's students, they are often easier to get hold of than the copies in the main University Library. There are also wellbeing and fiction sections to refocus your thoughts and revive your mind as well as a collection of music scores.

The library hosts activities and events throughout the year, many of which are student led.
