We realise that there is a lot of information to read through ahead of your arrival but please do take the time to read the below in full as it contains important information including details of Durham's COVID-19 testing procedures. If you are arriving tomorrow, we are so excited to meet you!

#### **Durham University's Face Covering Policy**

As it reopens the campus, Durham University requires all staff, students and visitors to wear face coverings if they can. To protect everyone at Van Mildert, we require students to wear masks in the main building, unless they are seated in the Dining Hall, the Bar, or the Library. We also expect students to wear masks in communal areas of the accommodation buildings, unless exempt from wearing masks on legitimate grounds. #### Bring your ID

Official identification is required to complete your enrolment at the University. We will do this for you at College Registration on Sunday 26 September. Please bring the original copy of your passport in order to complete this process.

If you are unable to attend College Registration because your arrival in College has been delayed or you are quarantining, you can arrange a time to have your identification verified and your University enrolment completed by emailing <u>vm.ug.newstudent@durham.ac.uk</u> (undergraduates) or <u>vm.pg.newstudent@durham.ac.uk</u> (postgraduates). Please note, you must not attend College Registration or any other in person events if you are quarantining.

#### Welcome and Orientation Week Timetable

We are pleased to share with you <u>here</u> the Van Mildert College Welcome and Orientation Week timetable. You will be offered a printed copy of this timetable upon arrival in College and we are looking forward to meeting you at many of the events shown.

#### A reminder about COVID-19 testing

We ask that all new students test before and on arrival. Please have the result of a COVID-19 test taken within the last 48 hours ready to show a COVID Marshal when you arrive in College. Tests from the NHS or another non-University provider are acceptable. We also ask that anyone accompanying you takes a test before entering University buildings. Please note we cannot provide testing facilities for non-students at the University.
