Key deadlines

The table below summarises the key deadlines that are approaching. More information about the deadlines can be found in the relevant sections of this update.

20.01.17	Deadline for TEIs to submit the confirmed modules marks from 2015/16 for continuing students.
27.01.17	Deadline for students to submit feedback to the student representatives on the Common Awards Management Board.
31.01.17	Deadline for TEIs to submit new programme proposals as part of the curriculum development process.
08.02.17	Deadline for TEIs to inform us of any errors in the student records data.

Module marks for continuing students

The deadline for TEIs to submit the confirmed module marks **from 2015-16** for any continuing students is **Friday 20th January 2016.** Please ensure that the marks are presented and returned securely on <u>the spreadsheet template</u>.

Please note that where students have withdrawn or have suspended their studies: if the student has completed a module then we need to receive the confirmed module marks for these modules in order to add them to the student's Banner record, so that we are able to produce a transcript for them if necessary.

Curriculum development

The next deadline for the submission of curriculum development proposals is **Tuesday 31**st **January 2017**. TEIs are asked to submit proposals for: (i) any programmes that are new to the TEI; (ii) any programmes that are new to a specific centre within a TEI; (iii) withdrawing a Common Awards programme.

TEIs are reminded that they can find information about <u>curriculum development</u> in the online <u>TEI Handbook</u>.

Please note that the deadline for other curriculum changes (e.g. programme and module changes) is not until the end of May 2017. If TEIs wish to submit these changes sooner, they are welcome to do so.

Staff training days:

Assessment and Exam Boards

We are pleased to announce that we will be running three staff training days on assessment and exam board processes, including:

- best practice in moderation procedures
- how to run exam boards
- Serious Adverse Circumstances (SAC) affecting student work
- plagiarism prevention, detection and response
- Durham reporting requirements (particularly of special cases: resits, long extensions, SACs, etc.)
- use of Turnitin and Moodle in connection with all of the above

Who should attend?

The training days will provide essential training for academic administrators, directors of study, chairs of exam boards and people who would play a lead role in dealing with plagiarism. It is recognised that large TEIs may have multiple people they wish to send and this is acceptable. However, it should be stressed that this training is NOT suitable for someone whose only involvement in assessment is first marking, moderating and attending exam boards.

Venues

The same training day is being offered in three locations: Bristol, Leeds and London. Each training day will be delivered jointly by Durham University staff and Ministry Division.

It is important that we receive notification of any errors by this date so that we have sufficient time to finalise the data prior to the issuing of invoices (1st March).

We recently contacted TEIs to ask you to submit the dates that your TEI Management Committees will be meeting during 2017. Thank you to everyone who has sent us their dates. Once we have received all the dates, we will work with the University Liaison Officers to identify which meetings they will be attending.

Student Conference

We are pleased to confirm that the 2017 Common Awards Student Conference will take place from **24**th-**27**th **July 2017** at <u>The Hayes Conference Centre</u> in Derbyshire. The theme for this year's conference is 'Church and World'.

Staff conference

The 2017 Common Awards Staff Conference will be taking place from **12**th-**14**th **July 2017** at Collingwood College in Durham.
