

Foundation Award in Theology, Ministry and Mission

This programme is available at the **Lincoln School of Theology** in part-time mode of study, normally over one year. After discussion with, and the agreement of, the Principal of the Lincoln School of Theology, this programme may be studied in part-time mode of study over two years, where there are good reasons to do so.

This programme is taught via blended delivery for the majority of modules, where approximately half of the teaching hours will be delivered in person, and half delivered online.

Level 4 (60 credits)
