

MA in Theology, Ministry and Mission

1. This programme is available at the **Lincoln School of Theology** in part-time mode of study over two, three or four years. Admissions requirements are normally a relevant upper second class Honours degree. See the MA Programme Specification for further details.
2. Students should note that not all modules will be taught in each academic year and that the availability of the optional modules is dependent upon the availability of appropriate staff to teach them. If considering an interruption of their studies, students should discuss the possible impact of this with Lincoln School of Theology staff.
3. This programme is taught via blended delivery for the majority of modules, where approximately half of the teaching hours will be delivered in person, and half delivered online.
