This programme is available at **Cuddesdon Gloucester and Hereford** in part-time modes of study. Students will negotiate their choice of modules with their tutor, in light of the ministry for which they are preparing or in which they are engaged, and according to module availability. Certain combinations of modules are excluded, as detailed in the module descriptors. The Programme Specifications for this 120 credit programme require a minimum 80 credits at Level 6, and a maximum 40 credits at Levels 4 and 5.
