

Certificate of Higher Education in Theology, Ministry and Mission (120)

1. This programme is available at **St Augustine's College of Theology** in part-time and full-time modes of study. Students can either attend all teaching in person or use a blend of in-person and online teaching. Some students will follow pathways designed to meet the expectations of their sponsoring Churches; others study independently. These regulations are differentiated in terms of curriculum structure by the modules selected from the Mission and Ministry and Theological Reflection & Reflective Practice Lists. Current pathways are designated as Initial Ministerial Education (Ordained Ministry) Phase 1 (OM1); Licensed Lay Ministry (LLM), subdivided into Reader (LLR) and Lay Pioneer (LLP); and Independent Students (IS). Information about pathways is primarily included for the benefit of the representative from the Churches' Quality in Formation Panel, though it will of course also be of interest to others.
