

Certificate of Higher Education in Christian Ministry and Mission (180)

1. This programme is available at **St Augustine's College of Theology** in part-time and full-time modes of study. Students can either attend all teaching in person, use a blend of in-person and online teaching (though some modules may only be available in either online or in-person format). Independent Students can also undertake the entire Level 4 stage of their programme in online mode. This option is available for part-time study only.

Some students will follow pathways designed to meet the expectations of their sponsoring Churches; others study independently. These regulations are differentiated in terms of curriculum structure by the modules selected from the Mission and Ministry and Theological Reflection & Reflective Practice Lists. Current pathways are designated as Initial Ministerial Education (Ordained Ministry) Phase 1 (OM1); Licensed Lay Ministry (LLM), subdivided into Reader (LLR), Lay Pioneer (LLP) and Lay Pastoral Ministry (LLPM); and Independent Students (IS). Information about pathways is primarily included for the benefit of the representative from the Churches' Quality in Formation Panel, though it will of course also be of interest to others. Indicative pathways are shown in the supplementary document, 'Indicative Pathways for Quality in Formation Panel'.

2. The tables below refer to the various delivery modes available as follows: (A) in-person delivery only; (B) online delivery only; (C) a combination of in-person and online delivery.
