


Graduate Diploma in Theology, Ministry and Mission (120 Credits)

1. This programme is available at St Augustine's College of Theology in part-time and full-time modes of study. Individual modules will typically be available in either online or in-person format. Some students will follow pathways designed to meet the expectations of their sponsoring Churches; others study independently. Current pathways are designated as Initial Ministerial Education (Ordained Ministry), subdivided in Phase 1 (OM1) and Phase 2 (OM2); and Independent Students (IS). Information about pathways is primarily included for the benefit of the representative from the Churches' Quality in Formation Panel, though it will of course also be of interest to others. Indicative pathways are shown in the supplementary document, 'Indicative Pathways for Quality in Formation Panel'.
2. Candidates may study and be assessed in level 4 or 5 modules up to the value of 40 credits.
