

MA in Theology, Ministry and Mission (180 Credits)

1. This programme is available both in part-time and full-time mode of study. Individual modules will typically be available in either online or in-person format. Some students will follow pathways designed to meet the expectations of their sponsoring Churches. Current pathways are designated as Initial Ministerial Education (Ordained Ministry), subdivided in Phase 1 (OM1) and Phase 2 (OM2); and Independent Study (IS). Information about pathways is primarily included for the benefit of the representative from the Churches' Quality in Formation Panel, though it will of course also be of interest to others. Indicative pathways are shown in the supplementary document, 'Indicative Pathways for Quality in Formation Panel'.
2. The tables below refer to the various delivery modes available as follows: (A) in-person delivery only; (B) online delivery only; (C) a combination of in-person and online delivery.
