

## Foundation Award in Theology, Ministry and Mission (60 credits)

This programme is available at St Stephen's House in full-time or part-time modes of study. Some modules may be delivered online, or in a blend of online and in-person teaching. Any decision to deliver some or all of a module online will be taken in consultation with the relevant tutor(s) and all students scheduled to take it. Consultation will begin at least six weeks before the start of teaching, and will include consideration of factors, such as demand, numbers, the situations of those involved and wider circumstances. A decision to deliver some or all of a module online will be published at least four weeks before the module commences.
