

MA in Worship and Liturgical Studies (180 credits)

1. This programme is available at **College of the Resurrection**, in part-time mode of study.
2. Students will negotiate their choice of modules with their tutor, in light of the ministry for which they are preparing or in which they are engaged.
3. The Programme Specification for this 180 credit programme requires a minimum 150 credits at Level 7, and a maximum 30 credits at Level 6.
