- Top 3 BUCS League Table University since 2012 – 3,000+ students participating
- Britain's largest participation programme (College Sport) 8,000+ students participating weekly
- 10,000 ʻwider community' facility and programme users annually ... including holiday camps involving 800 participants





Volunteering and Outreach <u>Volunteering - Durham University</u>

- Over 80 student-led volunteering projects covering the following themes: Physical Activity, Environment, Culture, Social Inclusion and Education
- Volunteering active within our Colleges, academic departments, the SU and clubs and societies amounting to over 40,000 hours per year.
- State of the art online platform showcasing all opportunities
- 200+ community partners and charities





The Performing Arts

<u>Music - Durham University</u> <u>Theatre - Durham University</u>

- Britain's largest number of music groups 100 in total
- 38 theatre companies only exceeded by Cambridge
- £2.5m Assembly Rooms Theatre renovation providing new opportunities for students and the wider community
- First university to receive all-Steinway accreditation with 58 new instruments just arrived
- New opportunities to explore with dance and creative film

Durham Leadership Framework - Durham University

- Over 2,500 students engaged including the externally funded international Laidlaw programme
- 250+ alumni mentors and speakers engaged
- Strong partnership links, leading to external recognition with the Institute of Leadership and Management
- Opportunity to understand yourself more effectively, self-reflect and further develop key graduate skills
