## How does this work?

For both exchange programmes: Non-European Exchange and European Exchange

All degree programmes allow students to apply for the Study Abroad programme (including combined/joint honours).

This is a pass/fail year and the grades do not affect the final degree classification.

The final degree programme will be BA/BSc XXXX with Year Abroad, and the student will receive a transcript from their host university.

## **Fees & Funding**

All exchange students only pay 15% of UG fee to Durham.

Students do not pay fees to host university – the exchange works on a reciprocal fee waiver basis.

Student finance should continue as normal. Students would receive maintenance loans as well as additional means-tested grants.

The University will bid to the UK Government <u>Turing</u> funding scheme to support Study Abroad Exchanges.



## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### Do I have to speak a foreign language?

You do not have to speak a foreign language to Study Abroad, although we would strongly encourage you to learn the basics prior to going.

## How many Institutions can I choose as part of my application, and will I be offered my first choice?

We ask you to choose a maximum of three. It is not guaranteed that you will be offered your first University choice, as some Universities may be more competitive than others and places are limited.

### What will I do about accommodation whilst abroad?

Most of our Exchange Partners offer campus accommodation; however, students may be expected to source their own accommodation and be prepared to live off campus. All Partners are obliged to assist students with finding accommodation.

# Do I have to apply for a degree 'with Study Abroad' before my studies commence at Durham University in order to be considered?

No, there is no pressure to apply early, you can apply for a Study Abroad programme in Michaelmas term in Year 2 and if you are accepted, your programme code will be changed to 'with Study Abroad' before the end of Year 2.

## Are there any academic requirements to apply to Study Abroad?

You must achieve a minimum overall average of 55% in Year 1 and confidently expect to achieve the same standard in Year 2 of your studies, with no failed modules or re-sits pending.
