NOMINATION & APPLICATION PROCESS

Nomination Form

Partner universities can find our Nomination Form on our <u>Incoming Exchange website</u>. Please send the completed form to to our Incoming Exchange team at <u>iexch@ucalgary.ca</u>.

Graduate Students must be nominated **by the priority deadline** as graduate student application evaluation is done by distinct academic departments and is not a guaranteed acceptance.

2 Online Application

After the nomination by their home university, students will receive a personalized link to our online incoming exchange application. The following supporting documents must be submitted upon completion of the online application:

- A scanned copy of the student's Official Transcript to be uploaded in the application form via Student Centre *unofficial transcripts are not accepted.
- **Proof of English Language Proficiency (if required)** to be submitted by email to iexch@ucalgary.ca. To view more information on our language requirements, visit <u>University of Calgary English Language Proficiency</u>.

*Faculty of Law applications must include a letter of intent and two academic references





AFTER BEING ACCEPTED, WHAT'S NEXT?

Course Approvals

Incoming exchange students must request approval to register in courses requiring pre-requisite/co-requisite review or other restrictions. Upon obtaining a course approval, students are not automatically registered in courses. Approval is requested from the faculty or department responsible for the course; information about this process is available in the Exchange Student Admission Guide, which will be provided to students upon acceptance. A reminder that not all courses are available to incoming exchange students. Please have students consult the <u>course restriction</u> section on our website prior to beginning the course approval process.

For faculty contact information, visit <u>University of Calgary - Faculty Advising</u>. For graduate students, the Faculty of Graduate Studies will request course approval on behalf of students. Please note that graduate exchange students must take the majority of their courses at the graduate level.

Course Registration

Students are not automatically registered in courses. After receiving approval to register in their desired courses (if required), incoming exchange students will need to log in on their Student Centre and register for their approved courses on their own.



All exchange students are required to maintain full-time status while studying at UCalgary. Undergraduate exchange students are required to register in at least three courses (9 units) minimum or five courses (15 units) maximum. Graduate exchange students are required to register in at least two courses (6 units) minimum.

Fee Payment


Incoming exchange students will pay their tuition and fees at their home institution. However, the following fees will be charged to them at UCalgary: Undergraduate exchange students will pay UPass (student transit pass) and Campus Recreation; Graduate exchange students will pay Campus Recreation, Group Insurance, and Student Services fees, and can opt-in to UPass if desired.

Incoming exchange students can pay their fees via Convera Global Pay or CIBC Payment. Payments should be initiated before the deadline as it takes 3-5 business days to process. To view more information on how to pay your fees, visit our <u>How-to Guide on Fees Payment</u>.

On-Campus Housing

UCalgary has several housing options on campus with different price ranges. This includes private or shared bedrooms on a hallway with a shared living space, small apartments with 1-4 bedrooms and a kitchen/living room, etc. Most on-campus housing allows students to choose between a meal plan or self-catered options.

Please note: **on-campus housing is not guaranteed due to limited availability**.


We recommend that incoming exchange students wishing to live on campus submit their housing application as soon as they have submitted their UCalgary online exchange application and obtain their University of Calgary Student ID Number. The housing application for Fall and Full Year opens in December, while the application for Winter opens May 1. Applications close as housing fills. Waitlists are available and based on the application date. The last set of offers will be released in December.

Off-Campus Housing

Off-Campus Housing is an alternative option for incoming exchange students. In this case, students must search & apply for the housing independently.

COST EXPECTATIONS LIVING IN CALGARY

On-Campus Housing	On-campus housing costs vary depending on the building and room type and range from \$3,400 - \$5,825 CAD per semester. For details, visit https://www.ucalgary.ca/ancillary/residence . Note that the rates posted on the Residence website are for 2 semesters and need to be divided by 2 to get the per semester rate.
Off-Campus Housing	The rate for off-campus housing depends on neighbourhood & type of housing. The UCalgary Welcome Centre (welcome@ucalgary.ca) can answer off-campus housing questions.
Books and Supplies	Estimated \$600 maximum per semester. Students can view textbook costs at the UCalgary Bookstore.
Food and Necessities	\$500-\$1500 per month, depending on lifestyle.
Phone Plan	\$40-\$60 per month, depending on plan details.

Course Registration Requirements:

- Request approval to register in any courses with restrictions.
- Registration is not automatic! Students must register themselves after receiving approval (see Page 6 for details)

Requirements for Paying Fees

- Tuition is paid to the home university, but all exchange students have additional fees paid to UCalgary.
- Fees can be paid via Convera or CIBC Payment. It takes 3-5 business days to process (see Page 6 for details).

Ordering Transcripts

- Transcripts are not provided automatically. Student must request their transcripts on their Student Centre. For more information, visit the How-to Order Transcripts.
- Students can order an Official Mailed Transcript or e-Transcripts. Official Mailed Transcripts are free while e-Transcripts are \$8 per request.

Housing Application

- Students can apply for residence as soon as they submitted their application and receive their UCID number.
- The housing application for Fall and Full Year opens in December, while the application for Winter opens May 1.
- Waitlists are determined by application date.
- Final housing offers for both Fall and Winter semesters will be sent by December.
