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About our programme

- The BA (Honours) Primary Education (QTS) is a three year degree programme with 75-90 undergraduate students per year group, around 250 in total.
- The BA Primary Education degree is carefully designed to develop critically aware, research-informed, thoughtful and skilled teachers.
- The programme combines an academic undergraduate BA (Hons) component (three years of study) and a professional component (120 days minimum school experience) towards Qualified Teacher Status (QTS).








Overview of the BA Primary Education Programme




Current Programme Structure




Proposed Programme Structure 2024-25





School Experiences 2023-24

Year 1

- weekly serial days in term 1 and 2
- six week teaching placement in EYFS in term 3
- Year 2
- weekly intensive placement days in Term 2 and 3
- Four week intensive placement in term 2-3
- six week teaching placement in KS1 or KS2. in term 3
- Year 3
- teaching ten week placement in KS1 or KS2 in term 1
- six week 'wider professional responsibilities placement' in term 3

Placements

- Y1- paired, formative and about 50% teaching
- Increase in duration, intensity and expectation from Y1-Y3;
- Y2- solo, assessed and about 60-70% teaching
- Y3 –solo, assessed and about 70-80% teaching
- During the placements you will:
- Plan (INTENT)
- Deliver (IMPLEMENT)
- Assess (IMPACT)
- Complete school based professional activities
- BE PROFESSIONAL

Serial Days: what do I do and why?

Key points:

- Serial days give you an opportunity to:
- gain school experience alongside a trained mentor
- get to know the systems and procedures in your school
- understand the children and their needs
- find out about resources
- teach your first lessons!

Entry requirements

* grade 4 or better in English, Maths and a National Curriculum Science subject

* ABB at A level or equivalent

PLUS

*you must have a well structured personal statement *be supported in your reference *and pass an interview



Interview

- Conducted by two people
- ► A professional discussion
- Pre-set activities to prepare
- No trick questions
- Looking for potential


